We need to be prepared for a notification of an immediate school closing, which would mean the implementation of distance learning for the entire district. That being said, parents and teachers should be reminding students that they should be bringing Chromebooks, chargers, and any relevant materials back and forth between home and school each day. Teachers, as well, should be prepared to transition into distance learning on very short notice without access to the building or their classrooms.

Should we experience a long-term closing, our distance learning schedule from last spring will be implemented. A copy of that schedule will be provided with the long-term notification if/when that should happen.
